The Idaho Transportation Department is preparing to replace the Fort Hall Interchange on Interstate 15 (Exit 80). ITD and the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes are working together to ensure that improvements will serve the community into the future.

The current interchange, which was built in 1958, is showing signs of wear and has reached the end of its design life. Projected improvements include a full replacement of the interchange and replacement of the creek and canal bridges. In addition, ITD will improve the connectivity between the on- and off-ramps and local roads.
