

### 93 Project Background



The EA was approved by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) in 2007 and a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was issued for the corridor improvements.


Minor changes have occurred in project design since the EA/FONSI; however, these changes have not caused additional environmental consequences to the resources in the project area.





# 93 Project Area Map





## [93] Typical Sections of Project Area



















# [93] Typical Section - Railroad Crossing






The project will expand the existing two-lane highway to four lanes with a center median and turn bays.




South End of the Project




North of Intersection with 340 South




At Intersections with 320 South and Railway Street




